Eligibility

- Interest in engaging in a research project at the University of Guanajuato during 8 weeks in June and July 2016.
- The research project can be conducted either in English or Spanish language, at the student convenience.

Students participate in different research projects proposed by UG faculty members in a broad range of fields of study. For the first time, in 2014, UG opened its Research Program along with Mexican culture immersion activities for International Students.

Application procedure

- 1) Applicants must send the following documents to internacional@ugto.mx before the deadline.
 - Résumé
 - Transcript
 - Motivation letter
 - Copy of Passport
- 2) Applicants will receive a personal login and password to complete online registration.
- 3) A letter of acceptance will be sent.
- 4) Applicants will be informed about research projects available during the process.

Scholarships available

- Partial reimbursement of air fare.
- Partial stipend for room and board.
- All applications will be considered for scholarship granting. No additional scholarship application needed.
