



SPECIFIC COOPERATION AGREEMENT
INTER-UNIVERSITY ACADEMIC EXCHANGE
BETWEEN
MARCHE POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY
AND
UNIVERSIDAD NACIONAL DEL LITORAL

The UNIVERSIDAD NACIONAL DEL LITORAL, Boulevard Pellegrini 2750, Santa Fe, Argentina, hereby the Rector in charge of the exercise of the Rector Dr. Enrique Mammarella, and the MARCHE POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY, Piazza Roma 22, Ancona, Italy, represented by the Rector Prof. Gian Luca Gregori, herewith conclude the present student-exchange agreement, according to the following terms:

FIRST

Both contracting parties will facilitate and develop a reciprocal student exchange program including undergraduate and graduate students, as a means to share their experiences and acquire a richer, more universal view of reality.

SECOND

Both universities agree to accept exchange students for periods of, one academic year maximum, or a semester minimum. The courses approved by the exchange students during those periods shall be acknowledged by the University of origin.

THIRD

-This cooperation will be carried out in programmes of study previously agreed upon by both institutions, between undergraduate and graduate students who have completed at least 40% of the courses/credits of their respective programmes.

FOURTH

Both universities mutually agree to:

Exchange an equal, previously agreed upon, number of students.

Determine annual exchange areas.

Waiver admission fees at the host university. Fees have to be paid at the university of origin.



Exchange lists of the subject areas, schedules, and requirements corresponding to their academic calendars.

Appoint academic coordinators of the exchange areas every year.

Produce an annual report on the results and possible improvements of the exchange programme.

Acknowledge the courses of study taken by the exchange students at the host university.

A previous commitment of academic acknowledgement (study contract) will be drawn between both institutions, establishing the courses to be taken at the host university and the courses acknowledged at the university of origin. The said contract should include the signatures of the dean/head/principal of the centre/school/faculty of origin, and eventually that of the dean/head/principal of the host centre/school/faculty.

FIFTH

The host university shall:

Send the necessary acceptance letters for the students' visa applications.

Provide an informative session before the students' incorporation to the university.

Provide information about accommodation and meals.

Allow the exchange students to have the same opportunities of access to, and use of, the university facilities and services as regular students.

Send reports on the students' incorporation and progress to the university of origin.

Send the students' final markings no later than thirty week days after having finished the academic year or the exchange period.

SIXTH

The participating institutions are responsible for proposing acceptable exchange candidates. These shall be selected after a rigorous process, taking into account their academic performance.

The application forms shall be sent before the previously established deadlines to the International Relations official at each institution.



The courses and subject areas to be taken by the exchange students shall be previously agreed upon between the university of origin, the host university, and the exchange students themselves.

Each university will draw the study contracts of its exchange students.

SEVENTH

The exchange students shall:

Obtain their corresponding visas.

Get an international health insurance and pay travel expenses.

Pay the fees established in the study contract at the university of origin.

Pay for the costs corresponding to study materials, services and activities not included in the present agreement.

Comply with the regulations, laws and statutes of both host country and university.

Comply with the academic requirements of the subject areas selected. Exchange students will be subject to the same regulations of assessment and approval as regular students.

SEVENTH BIS

Foreign students who wish to spend a period of academic practice during the student mobility at UNL, will define a plan of joint activities with the academic coordinators of each Department of UNL, which will require the applicant for Acceptance.

EIGHTH

In order to strengthen the exchange actions between both institutions, the following activities shall be promoted:

Organisation of academic and scientific meetings, symposia, seminars and other forms of joint cooperation, fostering the debate and exchange of scholarly experience.

Design of joint research projects and exchange of faculty and researchers.

NINTH

This Agreement shall enter into force upon the latter date of signature and shall remain in force for five (5) years. It shall be extended automatically for the same



period, unless otherwise expressed by one of the parties with at least six (6) months' advance notification in writing.

The Agreement will be composed in two copies. In witness whereof, the Rector of Marche Polytechnic University and the Rector of Universidad Nacional del Litoral sign the agreement on the day and year written below.
