## Curricular Units for 2022/2

#### Digital Thinking (Classes taught in English)

We live in several simultaneous revolutions: Cognitive, Scientific, Industrial and Technological. In this scenario, the English language is an important support tool and a means of access to this multiple knowledge that involves digital thinking. This Curricular Unity will address strategies and techniques for reading and interpreting English texts to analyze and discuss digital information and communication systems. Topics such as Artificial Intelligence, Digital Thinking and Data Analysis; Digital Society; The Technological Revolution; Industry 4.0; Internet of Things will be covered in order to develop reading and writing skills in the English language.

Dates and times: Thursdays or Fridays, from 19:00 to 21:50 (Brasilia time).

#### **Culture & Arts (Classes taught in English or Spanish)**

Concepts of culture and art; Interrelations between society, culture and art; Cultural identities; Culture and interpersonal relationships; Culture and art from the perspective of ideology; Culture, art, politics and human rights; Cultural citizenship; Paradigm of cultural diversity; Inclusion through culture and for culture; Culture and art in historical time; Culture and territory; Sustainable dimensions of culture; Brazilian cultures; Culture and art from the perspective of ethnic-racial relations; Cultural and artistic expressions and manifestations; Cultural industry; Ethics and aesthetics; Relations between taste and knowledge; Ugly versus beautiful; Beauty; Radicality and transgression; The languages of art in everyday life; The artistic being and artist; Creation, production, circulation and enjoyment of the arts; Art and sustainability; Inclusion through art; Culture, art and complex thinking; Culture and art in the construction of professional ethos; Cultural experiences; Artistic experiences.

Dates and times: Thursdays or Fridays, from 19:00 to 21:50 (Brasilia time).

# Environment, Sustainability and Social Analysis (Classes taught in English or Spanish)

Construction of a macro vision of social, political, economic, cultural issues and their relationship to human development and environmental balance. Technology, innovation, environmental education, socio-environmental ethics, new ways to consolidate human rights, ethno-racial diversity, gender issues, social exclusion and inclusion processes, pacts for sustainable development. Creating a new perspective on these relationships and for the adoption of new individual and collective attitudes aimed at building a more just and sustainable society.

Dates and times: Thursdays or Fridays, from 08:50 to 11:40 (Brasilia time).



# About the remote classes

#### Calendar:

- Classes start: August 11.
- End of classes: December 08.
- There will be 18 classes of 2h50min, totaling a course load of 51 hours.
- The selected professor may choose to teach on Thursdays or Fridays.
- The selected professor must be aware of possible time zone changes during the academic semester.
- Classes will have a mandatory 20-minute break, at a time of the professor's choice.

#### Others:

- Each Curricular Unity will have two classes a week: one will be taught by a Brazilian professor (51 hours) and the other will be taught by the selected foreign professor (51 hours).
- The semester workload for each Curricular Unity is 160 hours, of which 102 hours are classroom time and 58 hours are self study time.
- The remote classes will take place through Zoom platform, with the accesses being made available by Ânima.





# Requirements

- At least 2 years of experience as a higher education professor.
- Experience in the subject of the chosen Curricular Unity.
- Fluent English / Spanish (according to the language of the applied Curricular Unity).
- Availability to teach the Curricular Unity classes on the scheduled dates and times, respecting the time zone difference.

# Benefits

- Payment of fees for the classes taught.
- Certification by Ânima.
- Networking with Brazilian professors and students.


- Resume of the professor (preferably in English);
